Course Coverage

The course covers the following topics:

- Maritime Security Overview
- Maritime Security Threats, including Piracy, Armed robbery and Stowaway
- Detection of Threats
- Deterrence of Threats
- Security Response and Procedures
- Maintaining the conditions set out in a ship security plan
- Recognise security risks and threats
- Conduct of regular security inspections of the ship
- Proper use of security equipment and systems, if any

Pre-Requisite

- a. Employed or engaged as a ship's complement in any capacity on board ships which are required to comply with the ISPS code.
- b. For those who have designated duties under the ship security plans.

Certification
